2. Objectives of the Programme

The programme was organised with the objective of nurturing patriotism and national pride among students, promoting respect for the Indian National Flag, creating awareness about the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign, and encouraging collective participation in activities that strengthen the values of unity, responsibility and citizenship.

3. Activities Conducted

- 1. Har Ghar Tiranga Rally:** Students, teachers and staff participated in a rally beginning from the college campus and moving through the surrounding areas, carrying the National Flag and the programme banner.
- 2. Oath Taking:** Participants took a collective pledge reflecting respect for the nation, the National Flag and the values of responsible citizenship.
- 3. Vande Mataram:** The programme included the collective singing of Vande Mataram, adding a solemn and patriotic dimension to the observance.
- 4. National Flag Distribution:** National Flags were distributed among participants to encourage active participation in the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign.
- 5. Awareness Badges:** Awareness badges were distributed as part of the programme to reinforce the message of patriotic participation and civic awareness.
- 6. Student and Teacher Speeches:** Students and teachers addressed the gathering and shared messages on patriotism, national unity, respect for the Tricolour and the responsibilities of citizens.
